Description	The main parts of the prompt are incompletely addressed. The format may be inappropriate in places. The writer expresses a position, but the development is not always clear. Some main ideas are put forward, but they are limited and are not sufficiently developed and/or there may be irrelevant detail. There may be some repetition.	Organisation is evident but is not wholly logical and there may be a lack of overall progression. Nevertheless, there is a sense of underlying coherence to the response. The relationship of ideas can be followed but the sentences are not fluently linked to each other. There may be limited/overuse of cohesive devices with some inaccuracy. The writing may be repetitive due to inadequate and/or inaccurate use of reference and substitution. Paragraphing may be inadequate or missing. 

Some major social and practical challenges that people living abroad face stem from language barrier. I believe this can result in considerable social problems, but practical ones are not that big and can be solved.

Not knowing the nuances in the target language as a foreigner can cause loneliness. This is mainly due to breakdown in communication, which is of paramount importance in any relationship. A foreigner would not understand the jokes in that language, nor would he/she know the register and contextual use of some idiomatic expressions. Thus, should an immigrant not know such underlying details, they will feel left out in small groups and communities, which eventually leads to alienation at least at the beginning of their stay.

There might also be some practical problems while doing daily routines due to failure in understanding. Shopping for grocery or clothes, for instance, could be challenging if a person is not proficient enough to speak and comprehend the local language, he may end up purchasing an unwanted or useless item. Another example would be when asking for direction which could result in misunderstanding leading to choosing the wrong route and wasting their time, which ultimately makes them furious. However, thanks to technology, such problems can be addressed without much hassle. For example, Google Map, Translate applications, and online shopping have enabled many foreign residents to do their daily routines with ease.

In conclusion, granted, there are some practical problems involved in living in a foreign country where you do not have a good command of its language, but the internet and numerous applications have addressed such issues. However, social activities which require a more in-depth connection cannot be addressed easily unless an immigrant gradually achieves the proficiency in the language.
